- Manage compliance with various US Free Trade Agreements, including creating and issuing export preferential Certificates of Origin such as USMCA, KORUS, CAFTA, etc.
- Review and validate Export Compliance Documentation (EEI's, BOL's, COO's etc.) to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements (U.S. Department of Commerce and Census)
- Work with freight forwarders, customs brokers or others to ensure export compliance regulatory requirements are being met
- · Develop and maintain procedural guidance relative to export compliance regulatory filings
- Complete, obtain and/or review required documents and information necessary to support US Export Compliance regulations, and P66 export compliance policies
