FTZ Compliance Review Checklist for FTZ Operators

This document will be provided to FTZ Operators in order to streamline preparation and provide situational awareness for CBP Compliance Reviews.

How can a FTZ Operator Prepare for a CBP Compliance Review?

Ensure that the following are up-to-date:

- o Procedures Manual
- o Blueprint of the Activated Area
- o Type "4" Bond
- o List of FTZ Users, if applicable
- o Facility security measures (video surveillance, fencing, access control, etc.)
- o FTZ Signage

> Be able to provide FTZ-related documentation, including the following but may not be limited to:

- o Last calendar year's Annual Reconciliation Letter
- o Any correspondences with CBP related to alterations of activated space, minor boundary modification requests, and production authority requests and approvals
- o FTZ Activation Letter from CBP
- CBP Form 216 Annual Blanket Permit, signed and dated by CBP, for current calendar year
- o Proof of destructions, if applicable, via CBP Form 216
- o Proof of temporary removals and/or deposits, if applicable, via CBP Form 216

What to expect during a CBP Compliance Review?

- ➤ CBP Officer may request a meeting with the FTZ Operator upon arriving at the facility for the compliance review
- ➤ Ensure that the FTZ Operator representative is available to CBP for the duration of the compliance review
- ➤ CBP Officer may request FTZ admissions and requisite documentation for review
- ➤ CBP Officer may assess the facility's current security measures
 - o This may include a review of the physical segregation and direct identification of any goods subject to a Withhold Release Order, detention, or an exclusion order
- ➤ CBP Officer may conduct a closeout meeting to discuss the preliminary results of the compliance review
