- Provides or directs the preparation of entry papers from invoice, in accordance with customs regulations and regulations of other governmental agencies bearing on importation and/or exportation of goods, if import or export of goods are involved.
- Converses with shipping brokers concerning export and import papers, docking facilities, or packing and marking procedures.
- Makes recommendations regarding packing procedures and may inspect packed or crated goods for conformance to shipping specifications to prevent damage, delay, or penalties.
- Determines duty rates on goods to be imported, based on knowledge of governmental tariffs and excise taxes.
- Files papers, audits invoices for accuracy, and arranges for payment. Assigns HTS codes, Schedule B's and ECCNs to import or exported products.
- Will be responsible for submission of customs rulings, other Government exemptions (e.g. DOT exemptions), export license submissions, and Foreign National Reviews.
- Conducts Free Trade Agreement Analysis, assigns country of origin to imported and exported products.
- Works with Sales teams to review customers for end-use and export screening decisions, including embargo country screening, export license determination, restricted party screening.
- Serve as the main point of contact for U.S. Customs Brokers and Freight Forwarders for issues with day to day questions.
- Responsible for value reconciliation and drawback entries in the U.S. and Canada.
