- Utilize internal and external partners to develop cross-functional teams to set and achieve and performance objectives.
- Create and maintain Standard Operating Procedures for the logistics organization. Lead Continuous Improvement initiative to constantly test and evaluate procedures and optimize efficiencies.
- Assist Leadership with the creation and implementation of strategic initiatives. Maintain and review priorities with teams on a daily, weekly, monthly, quarterly, and annual cadence.
