Under general supervision, performs all duties related to Domestic and International shipments. This includes the preparation of diversified documentation for exporting company products into foreign countries following the guidelines, policies, regulations of the United States. Monitor the importation of product into the United States ensuring that regulatory compliance is maintained for product identification.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Coordinate the movement of products/equipment/materials in and/or out
 of the country in accordance with organizational policy and procedure,
 and to comply with relevant local, country and international law and
 process as requested.
- Complete the necessary documentation and online forms for the efficient, cost-effective and lawful execution of all import/export activities.
- Coordinate and conduct our business practices with forwarding agents and brokers to affect regulatory compliance within our Import and Export programs.
 Maintain current documentation forms and any other necessary records to perform to job.
- Coordinate with the necessary parties (Engineering, Purchasing, Technology Control Officer) to determine and maintain the classification (ECCN, HTS, Schedule B) of our products to ensure international trade compliance with the regulatory agencies.

- Collect data to complete monthly freight transportation or crating reports as required for management review.
- Update processes due to relevant changes within our Import-Export
 Trade Compliance Manual as required and maintain and share with colleagues.
- Train and certify to file with AES Direct and maintain compliance for reporting of export declarations.
- Perform all activities related to domestic and international shipments including:
- Picking
- photographing
- boxing parts orders
- Monitoring production schedules to ensure product can be crated and shipped on time
- Pack, move and load product into crates/trucks to go to the craters
- Ship goods via customer specified instructions or company guidelines
- Conduct transactions in ERP system as well as LeanKit
- Complete all appropriate domestic and international shipping paperwork
 and documents
- Conduct Denied Party screening for shipments or per request
- Communicate effectively with carriers, customers and John Crane associates.
- Operate forklift and cranes on a daily basis to load, unload and move product.
- Conduct daily inspections of Forklift(s) and Walkie(s) and routine inspections of cranes and lifting equipment.
- Cross train in other functions and perform other duties as assigned.
- Complete all 5S duties and maintain a clean, safe, and professional working environment.
- Participate in Lean/Continuous Improvement activities
- Other duties as assigned.
