- Support Trade Compliance managers in various trade related activities, including FTA solicitations, ISF filings, and updating of internal and external Business Rules and process flows, training presentations, and other activities;
- Support Trade Compliance managers with compliance and metrics reporting, and data mining;
- Assist with future Foreign Trade Zone (FTZ) management and filings as backup;
