Responsible for ensuring compliance with all applicable US & Canadian trade laws and regulations, as well communicating these requirements to internal and external partners. Audits imports/exports and proactively monitors transactions prior to arrival of cargo and through post-entry reviews. Serves as an import/export liaison for international customers/subsidiaries, distribution, procurement, planning, manufacturing, intercompany finance, regulatory and import/export compliance functions.

Essential Job Duties:

- Analyzes regulations and procedures and relates them to operations company-wide.
- Conducts monthly post-entry audits on US or Canadian imports against financial reports or order data to identify process deficiencies.
- Classifies product for import/export to the US and Canadian tariffs.
- Implements improvements in critical areas of trade in terms of documentation, valuation, duty recovery and HS classification.
- Reviews broker/forwarder documentation for correct values, commodity classifications, tariff codes and authorizations.
- Leads engagement with Information Technologies teams and other resources within the business to define, design and develop solutions on trade compliance matters to mitigate risks and improve efficiency.

- Maintains applicable trade compliance records in accordance with regulatory requirements.
- Updates trade related data in Trade Compliance 3rd party or proprietary software and Enterprise Resource Planning systems.
- Participates in training & assessment projects to ensure effectiveness of internal controls.
- Assists senior management to develop, maintain and deliver training on Customs and Trade topics as needed to internal and external partners.
- Promptly informs senior management of any suspected violations of trade regulations by company employees or service providers (customs brokers or freight forwarders).
- Manages US/CA broker and forwarder (3rd party) service failures and implements solutions
- Investigates and resolves compliance concerns, questions, or complaints.
- Assume other duties as assigned.
