



WHAT QUALIFIES FOR CE CREDIT?

Non-Qualifying Activities

- Social events (happy hours, sports outings)
- Government-led meetings (COAC, ITAC, TSN, etc.)
- Reading or authoring trade publications/thought pieces
- Individual professional development
- Courses administered by an academic institution as part of their curriculum
- Sales or marketing events

Qualifying Activities

- Industry or trade-related conferences, seminars, and webinars
- Online, self-administered courses (also known as asynchronous)
- Company trainings (internally developed or offered by an outside vendor)
- Port tours
- Trade days sponsored by local associations

CRITERIA FOR CE CREDIT

- Criteria #1 The activity promotes an understanding of the laws and regulations governing CBP or enforced by CBP, including relevant laws and regulations of CBP's partner government agencies.
- Criteria #2 The activity contributes directly to CBP's trade priorities, programs, policies, and/or business practices.
- Criteria #3 The activity provides understanding of U.S. imports and exports.
- Criteria #4 The activity conveys information intended to increase and improve U.S. trade compliance and enhance risk management.


CE HOURS CALCULATION


- Number of credits in 0.5-hour increments
- Add all eligible activity in minutes, divide by 60
- Round to the nearest increment within 10 minutes
- Example: Seminar with Lunch
 - > 225 minutes ÷ 60 minutes = 3.75
 - > 3.75 3.5 = must be *greater than or equal to* 0.32 hours (0.16 \times 2) to count for 0.5 credits
 - \geqslant 3.75 3.5 = 0.25, which is not greater than or equal to 0.32, so 15 minutes of credit is not awarded
 - > Total Credit hours = 3.5 hours
- Example: Self-Administered Course
 - Must have a test or exam
 - > 10 hours = 1 CE

CE RECORD KEEPING

- The name of the provider or host of the education
- The date(s) attended
- The location of the education
- The number of CE credits accrued
- Documentation from the education provider that evidences the broker's registration and attendance...
 - ✓ Registration Receipt/Invoice
 - ✓ Certificate of Completion




