- Reconciling customs statements (CBP, CARM) related to duties and taxes, and ensuring the finance team receives accurate, timely data.
- Contributing to compliance education across the business—developing training, sharing best practices, and supporting onboarding for relevant teams.
- Conducting in-depth research on Customs rulings and submitting binding ruling requests when appropriate.
- Assessing eligibility for Free Trade Agreements (FTAs), preparing required documentation and certifications.
- <u>Determining if additional Participating Government Agency (PGA)</u> <u>clearances are necessary for any imports.</u>
- Working alongside the wider compliance team to strengthen internal customs processes and ensure end-to-end adherence to global trade policies.
- Continuously refining internal SOPs and developing new control mechanisms to mitigate risk and ensure operational alignment.
