The Senior Import Analyst performs analysis and executes project and transactional needs within the US and Canada Import Operations team. Partners with internal and external team related functional areas and service providers to maintain compliance with regulatory requirements for US and Canada imports (e.g., Customs, FDA, Health Canada, and Participating Government Agencies). Collaborates with 3rd party Brokerage companies, to establish and maintain shared systems, processes and methods of service level measurements to support time sensitive customs clearance demands. Internally review and audit trade data and share audit findings to

maintain or improve service level, service quality and compliance efficiencies. Support and maintain workable dashboards to demonstrate department KPIs in productivity, quality and service.

- Maintain, develop or update reporting and technical tools to execute audit and trade data analysis
