- Manage and validate FTA supplier qualifications
- Audit Customs entries and ensure broker accuracy and PGA compliance
- Conduct restricted-party screenings for import transactions
- Maintain accurate classification, COO, and trade data in internal systems
- Partner with East Coast engineering, manufacturing, sourcing, and logistics teams to gather technical details
- Support continuous improvement of import compliance processes, SOPs, and workflows
- Respond to internal stakeholder inquiries related to U.S. import requirements
